

THE CHALLENGE OF COMPLIANCE



McFall Fuel is finding that the challenge of achieving compliant deliveries to customers needs constant vigilance. While we are focussed on first class service we also need to ensure that what we do is safe for our customers, our drivers, and the environment. We have made several attempts at advising customers that the smaller containers are

designed to be filled at service station pumps because they have smaller auto shut-off nozzles and air vents. The nozzles on our delivery vehicles are bigger than those at service stations and the pump rate from the trucks is significantly faster than the service stations auto shut-off nozzles. This means there is not enough airflow out of the container when the fuel is going in causing bubbling and the blowback of fuel. We are not able to safely secure the containers when filling them, which increases the risk of them falling over causing product to ground. On occasions, where containers not certified for fuel use and are filled, the quality of the fuel cannot be guaranteed due the potential of residual contaminants in the container. These contaminants can then be introduced into machines, vehicles, and equipment. We encouraged customers to work with their sales representatives to find a solution by the 1st October 2018. We have now reached the point where drum or container filling will cease from March 31, 2019.

The Driving and Commercial Teams' at McFall Fuel will be focusing on tank compliance next and working with customers to resolve issues from March 2019 so that we can be confident all tanks we deliver to are safe and or compliant to deliver to by the beginning of 2020.

LUUKA IS PREPARING FOR 2019 WORLD CHAMPS



Luuka Jones is on a three week canoe slalom training camp in Australia which has been going well so far. "We raced at the Australian Open and there were so many paddlers who had come from the Northern Hemisphere to train. The start list was huge. This made it a great race for getting a gauge of where I am at. Even though we are still quite far from the start of the season, it is still a good indication of how I have been tracking in the months since the world champs. I actually felt really good in the race in terms of speed. I made some mistakes which in the past

would have dropped me down the ranks a lot but last weekend I was still up there. I will work on tidying up my races and eliminating errors but good to see I'm in a strong position," said Luuka. "This year is pretty big in terms of planning (lots of travelling) and time away. The 2019 World Championships count for Olympic selection, so all nations will be out to qualify for the 16 or so spots that are available at this race. Following the world champs we have two Tokyo training camps, so it draws the season out a bit."

"I'm pretty excited about getting to Tokyo and seeing what it's like over there. We have already started looking ahead to the Games and - assuming qualification goes smoothly - trying to prepare for the conditions there. It's likely to be very hot and humid around Games time so its important to be prepared for this. I did a test in the heat chamber the other day. It was pretty hard! We had the chamber heated to 35 degrees and 75% humidity. I did a session on the erg and was in there for about an hour and a half. It was pretty hard to recover from and on the whole a very challenging experience. I will do another when I return from Australia to see if I have made any heat adaptations in the climate here," said an excited Luuka.
